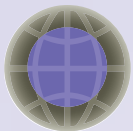

Our Mission

Preventable blindness is a global tragedy. An estimated 80 percent of the world's cases of blindness are due to treatable or preventable disorders such as cataracts, glaucoma, infection, and the ocular complications of diabetes. Treatment for these conditions is available readily in the United States, but remains beyond the reach of many people living in the developing world.

IRIS is a nonprofit organization dedicated to preventing blindness and to restoring the vision of afflicted individuals in the developing world. Working directly with native health-care providers, IRIS strives to end avoidable blindness through education and equipment donation. In addition, IRIS recognizes the importance of supporting and encouraging local medical personnel, who form the front-line in the war against global blindness.

Our Methods

IRIS works toward reducing blindness through the following efforts:

Equipment

- Donating high-tech operating room microscopes, diagnostic equipment, and lasers to clinics to enable the safe, efficient treatment of cataracts, glaucoma, ocular complications of diabetes, and other serious eye diseases.
- Purchasing medical supplies for operating rooms and clinics.
- Providing medications to treat non-surgical ocular diseases.

Education

- Delivering books, DVDs, and journals to educate native medical workers in the latest techniques and procedures.
- Visiting sites and teaching local providers about new technology and surgical methods.
- Holding conferences and seminars to alert medical professionals to the ocular needs of people living in the developing world.
- Providing funding for educational advancement of native health-care workers.

Encouragement

- Encouraging the public to support government and private endeavors to prevent blindness globally.
- Encouraging eye-care providers and other medical professionals to participate in medical missions.
- Encouraging native health-care providers by working side-by-side as colleagues.
